Students will be written up and referred to the office ONLY after two interventions have been put into place on Level One and Two Offenses. A cumulative sheet will be kept on each student in his/her discipline file in the SMS office by the principal and/or the principal's representative.

## LEVEL ONE OFFENSES

First Discipline Referral: Conference with student by Mrs. Cole or her representative

Second Discipline Referral: Call home by teacher or office personnel

Third Discipline Referral: Student goes to Grade Level Teacher Meeting (PLC)

Referrals mailed home/ Conference with Parent/s;

Possible Internal Suspension

Fourth Discipline Referral: Internal Suspension

- 2. DO ANNOUNCEMENTS OR BE EXCUSED FROM CLASS FOR SPECIAL PRIVILEGES

## **LEVEL TWO OFFENSES**

First Discipline Referral - Phone call home/ conference with teachers and Mrs. Cole Second Discipline Referral - Internal Suspension (number of days to be determined by incident or number of times in internal previously served)

<u>Third Discipline Referral</u> - After three internal days – automatic external suspension

## LEVEL THREE OFFENSES
