LEVEL FOUR OFFENSES

Immediate 10 day external suspension with letter to superintendent for expulsion for the rest of the school year.

**After 10 days in internal suspension, further offenses will result in external suspensions. Special education students will receive a manifestation hearing before 10 days of suspension.

All other forms of misbehavior will receive a consequence determined by the state law, principal and/or the discipline committee.

Anti-Hazing Plan: Sherrard Middle School is committed to providing a safe and orderly environment for all students. We promote a setting of respect, civility, and dignity. We prohibit any person or group from engaging in any form of hazing activity. Any student engaging in hazing will be subject to disciplinary action that could include exclusion, suspension, expulsion or loss of participation in extracurricular activities.

Bullying, Harassment and Intimidation Policy

Purpose: To provide a learning environment that is safe and free from intimidation and fear of being harmed.

Definition: Any intentional act (verbal, written, or physical) that harms or is <u>perceived</u> as harming others and/or damaging or threatening to damage a student's property.

Examples of "Bullying" could be gestures, written, verbal, or physical or threats that are intimidating or threatening to another person or their property. Repeated actions are considered a form of harassment or bullying.

Enforcement: This policy applies to all persons on any school property or attending a school activity. Students are encouraged to report any incident to the principal. All complaints will be investigated and a record kept of each incident. The principal or a representative will investigate each complaint. Possible disciplinary action may include warnings, written reprimands, suspension and/or expulsion.
